

Jumper length corresponding to pigtail



Article Overview

Standard pigtail jumper lengths range from 1 meter to 5 meters, with specific lengths depending on fiber count and type.

Standard Lengths

- Simplex pigtails (single fiber) are typically 1 meter (3.3 ft) in length .
- Multi-fiber pigtails such as 6-, 12-, and 24-fiber assemblies are usually 2 meters (6.6 ft) in length .
- Manufacturers like Siemon also offer custom lengths of 1, 2, 3, and 5 meters, with options for special jacket colors or configurations .

Connector and Breakout Considerations

- The connector length is included in the total pigtail length. For example, a 1-meter pigtail includes the connector ferrule at one end, so the fiber portion is slightly shorter than the total length .
- Multi-fiber pigtails often have a breakout length of approximately 36 inches (915 mm) to allow easy installation and splicing .

Applications and Notes

- Pigtail jumpers are designed for splicing to fiber cables in telecommunications, data centers, and high-performance network environments .
- They are generally un-jacketed and intended for indoor use within splice trays or enclosures
