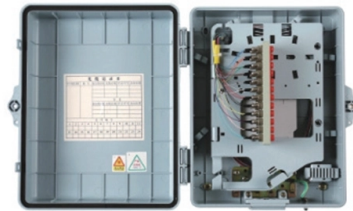


Method for splicing 4-core optical fiber to pigtail

Overview

A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and bare fiber on the other, designed to be spliced to incoming fiber cables in the field (). For a 4-core fiber, each individual fiber must be carefully prepared, aligned, and fused to maintain low insertion loss and high return loss.

Tools and Preparation

Before splicing, ensure you have:

- Fiber cleaver for precise cutting of fiber ends ()
- Fusion splicer capable of handling multi-core fibers
- Fiber stripper to remove protective coatings
- Cleaning materials (isopropyl alcohol, lint-free wipes)
- Splice protection sleeves to secure the joint Cleanliness is critical; even small dust particles can increase signal loss ().
