

Methods for handling loose strands in optical fiber cables



Article Overview

Proper handling of loose strands in optical fiber cables involves careful preparation, securing buffer tubes, maintaining bend radius, and using appropriate routing techniques to prevent damage and signal loss.

Cable Preparation and Sheath Removal

Before handling loose strands, the outer sheath of the cable must be carefully removed to expose the core and buffer tubes. Mark the sheath at the required distance, typically around 2 meters from the cable end, and use a sheath knife to make a ring cut without damaging the ripcord or strength members. Flex the cable gently to separate the sheath and remove it, exposing the color-coded buffer tubes and central strength member for further handling .

Securing and Routing Loose Strands

Once exposed, buffer tubes and loose strands should be properly secured to prevent movement that could cause attenuation or breakage. Within closures or splice trays, loop the buffer tubes to accommodate up to 10 mm of movement and secure them in place. Central members, such as GRP rods, should be clamped to prevent pistoning and contact with fibers . Proper routing ensures that loose strands are not stressed or bent beyond their minimum bend radius .
