

Number of wires coming out of the distribution box

The number of wires coming out of a distribution box depends on the number of circuits it serves, typically ranging from 6 to 24 circuits in residential setups, with each circuit having at least a phase, neutral, and earth wire.

Overview

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or breaker box, receives power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple circuits, each protected by circuit breakers or fuses. The wires coming out of the box correspond to these circuits and include:

- Phase (live) wires: Carry current to the load.
- Neutral wires: Complete the circuit back to the source.
- Earth (ground) wires: Provide safety by preventing electric shock.

Typical Residential Setup

In a single-phase domestic distribution box:

- The main input usually consists of a phase and neutral wire connected to a double-pole main MCB.
- Each output circuit has at least one phase wire and one neutral wire connected to single-pole MCBs....
