An OTN device connects to an optical cable using optical transceivers that convert electrical signals into light for transmission over fiber and vice versa, enabling high-speed, multi-service transport.

How OTN Devices Interface with Optical Fiber

OTN (Optical Transport Network) devices serve as the backbone for transporting diverse client signals—such as Ethernet, IP, SONET/SDH, and storage traffic—over optical fiber networks. These devices use optical transceivers to interface with fiber cables, converting electrical signals from the device into light pulses that travel through the optical medium, and converting incoming light back into electrical signals for processing .

OTU Interfaces and Signal Mapping

OTN devices employ OTU (Optical Channel Transport Unit) interfaces, such as OTU1, OTU2, OTU3, and OTU4, which define the line rate and payload capacity for different types of client signals. These interfaces are standardized under ITU-T G.709 and support Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM), allowing multiple optical channels to share the same fiber while maintaining signal integrity . The OTU interface ensures proper encapsulation, error correction, and monitoring of the optical signal.

- **Transceiver Installation:** The OTN device is equipped with an SFP, SFP+, or QSFP optical transceiver compatible with the desired OTU interface....
