Article Overview

ODF patch panels use standardized fiber color codes to identify individual fibers, typically following a sequence like blue, orange, green, brown, slate, white, red, black, yellow, violet, rose, and aqua.

Standard Fiber Color Coding

In optical distribution frames (ODFs) and patch panels, each fiber within a cable is assigned a specific color to simplify identification, splicing, and patching. The most commonly used 12-fiber color sequence is:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
- Brown
- Slate (Gray)
- White
- Red
- Black
- Yellow
- Violet
- Rose (Pink)
- Aqua

This sequence repeats for higher fiber counts, such as 24, 48, or 96 fibers, often organized in bundles of 12 fibers per tube or splice tray
