Optical fiber cables have a core, cladding, protective coatings, and sometimes strength members, but no metal conductor is required for signal transmission . **Applications:** Electrical cables are used for power transmission and low-end data communication, while optical fiber cables are primarily used for high-speed data communication over long distances . **Electromagnetic Interference:** Optical fibers are immune to electromagnetic interference, unlike electrical cables, which can be affected by nearby electrical fields .
