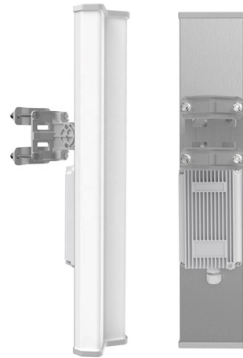


Plug the optical module into the fiber optic transceiver



Article Overview

To connect an optical module to a fiber optic transceiver, insert the SFP module into the device port, remove dust caps, clean the fiber connectors, and plug in the fiber with correct TX/RX alignment.

Step-by-Step Connection Process

1. Prepare the Equipment and Workspace

- Ensure the network device (switch, router, or media converter) is powered off or in a safe state for hot-swapping.
- Wear an ESD wrist strap and work on an antistatic mat to prevent electrostatic discharge damage to the optical module ().
- Keep dust caps on the SFP module and fiber connectors until ready to connect.

2. Insert the Optical Module

- Slide the SFP or SFP+ module gently into the compatible port until it clicks and is fully seated.

- Verify the module is securely inserted; improper insertion can cause intermittent links or damage the port ().

3. Prepare the Fiber Optic Cable

- Remove the dust caps from both the SFP module and the fiber patch cable.
- Clean the fiber end-face using a lint-free wipe or fiber cleaning tool to remove dust or contaminants, which can reduce signal quality ().

- Ensure the fiber type matches the module: single-mode fiber for single-mode SFPs and multimode fiber for multimode SFPs ().
