While it is technically possible to run power and low-voltage cables in the same tray under strict conditions, segregation or shielding is strongly recommended to ensure safety, compliance, and system reliability. Designed with robust insulation and jacketing options, these cables offer the durability. A common question arises: Can power cables and instrumentation/communication cables be run in the same cable tray?
