- **Chemical Safety:** Splicing often involves adhesives and cleaning agents. Use gloves, eye protection, and ensure adequate ventilation when handling epoxies, alcohols, or other chemicals to avoid irritation or inhalation hazards .
- **Hygiene:** Avoid touching your eyes or face while handling fibers, and wash hands thoroughly after splicing. Keep food and drinks away from the work area to prevent ingestion of fiber particles .

Technical Precautions

- **Power Disconnection:** Ensure all light sources and electrical power are disconnected before splicing to prevent eye injury or electrical shock .
- **Fiber Preparation:** Strip the fiber jacket carefully without damaging the core, clean fibers with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol, and cleave fibers with a precision cl...
