

# Ratio of random inspections of distribution boxes



## Article Overview

The ratio of distribution boxes to inspect randomly is typically determined using statistical sampling plans, often guided by AQL standards, and depends on batch size, inspection level, and acceptable defect rate.

### Determining Sample Size

Random inspection involves selecting a subset of boxes from a larger shipment to assess overall quality. The sample size is influenced by:

- Lot size: Total number of boxes in the shipment.
- Inspection level: ISO 2859-1 defines normal and special inspection levels (e.g., Level I, II, III) to balance inspection cost and protection.
- AQL (Acceptable Quality Level): Maximum percentage of defective items considered acceptable. Common AQLs for major defects range from 1% to 2% depending on product criticality. For example, a common industry practice is to select a number of boxes equal to at least the square root of the total number of boxes for a preliminary random inspection. This ensures a statistically significant sample while keeping inspection costs manageable.

### Sampling Methods

- Simple Random Sampling: Each box has an equal chance of being selected. Suitable for smaller shipments or when defects are expected to be evenly distributed...
