

Requirements for Horizontal Cable Tray Turning Supports



Article Overview

Horizontal cable tray turns must be supported to maintain structural integrity, prevent cable damage, and comply with load and spacing standards.

Support Spacing and Load Considerations

Horizontal turns in cable trays require adequate support to prevent sagging or mechanical strain on cables. The distance between supports depends on the tray type, material, and total cable load. Ladder trays, ventilated troughs, and solid-bottom trays each have manufacturer-specified maximum support spans, which must be followed to ensure safety and compliance with NEC 392.22 and DIN EN 61537 standards. Overloading or exceeding support spans can lead to cable deformation, insulation damage, or reduced current-carrying capacity.

Support Methods for Horizontal Turns

Common support methods include:

- Cantilever brackets: Mounted to walls for horizontal runs along vertical surfaces.
- Trapeze hangers: Suspended from ceilings to support horizontal tray sections.
- Angle or elbow supports: Specifically designed for horizontal bends to maintain the tray's shape and prevent twisting. Supports should be placed close to the bend, typically at or just beyond the turning point, to maintain the minimum bend radius and prevent cable stress.
