

Secondary distribution box incoming line closed



Article Overview

Closing the incoming line to a secondary distribution box energizes the downstream bus and loads, but must be coordinated with protective devices and system configuration to ensure safety and continuity.

Understanding the Incoming Line

In a secondary distribution box or unit substation, the incoming line typically comes from a primary feeder or substation transformer and feeds the secondary low-voltage bus and downstream circuits . Closing this line effectively connects the secondary bus to the primary source, supplying power to all connected loads.

Operational Considerations

- **Coordination with Breakers and Switches** The incoming line is usually protected by a circuit breaker or fused switch. In loop or dual-source configurations, the secondary main breaker must be opened before closing the primary incoming switch to prevent backfeed or fault currents . This ensures that only the intended bus is energized and avoids overloading or damaging equipment.
- **System Configuration**
- **Radial systems:** Closing the incoming line energizes all downstream loads directly, but any fault downstream will interrupt service until cleared .
- **Loop or selective systems:** If the substation is part of a loop, closing the incoming line can restore service to one bus while the other bus may remain isolated in case of a fault . Bus tie breakers may be used to balance loads or isolate faults....
