

Spacing of horizontal supports for cable tray installation



Article Overview

For horizontal cable tray runs, supports are typically spaced between 1.5 meters and 3 meters, depending on tray type, load, and installation conditions.

Recommended Support Spacing

For straight horizontal sections of cable trays, the support span—the distance between supports—generally ranges from 1.5 meters to 3 meters. This spacing ensures structural stability, prevents sagging, and allows for easy maintenance and cable access (Apex Tray). At corners, bends, or T-junctions, supports should be installed on each side of the turn, arranged symmetrically to prevent stress on the cables. For heavy-duty or long-span trays, supports can extend up to 6 meters, but this depends on the manufacturer's load capacity chart and the total weight of the cables (NEC 392). Always consult the tray manufacturer for specific load ratings and maximum allowable spans.

Support Types and Installation

- Hanging rod supports should have a minimum diameter of 8 mm and be used where trays are suspended from ceilings or beams.
- Fixed supports should be placed at key points: the start and end of the tray, corners, T-junctions, and for spans exceeding 30 meters.
- Horizontal cable fastening: Cables should be secured at the start, end, turns, and every 3 to 5 meters along straight runs to maintain organization and prevent mech...
