

Standard Size of Distribution Box Markings



Article Overview

Markings on a distribution box should be large enough to be easily read from a safe distance, typically with letters at least 1/4 inch high for close viewing and larger for visibility from several feet away.

Recommended Label Size and Legibility

For safety and compliance, labels on distribution boxes must be clearly legible. OSHA standards specify that signal words must be readable from a distance of 5 feet (1.52 meters), which implies that the text size should be sufficient for quick identification in emergencies or maintenance situations . In practice:

- Minimum letter height: 1/4 inch (6 mm) for labels viewed at close range.
- For visibility from 5 feet or more: letters should be at least 1/2 inch (12 mm) high.
- Font style: Use clear, sans-serif fonts to maximize readability.
- Contrast: High contrast between text and background (e.g., black on yellow or white on red) improves visibility .

Labeling Considerations

- Circuit identification: Each breaker or circuit should be marked to indicate the area or equipment it controls .
- Voltage and current ratings: Include voltage and amperage to prevent misuse or overloading
