

Start and end points of labeling distribution boxes



Article Overview

Labels on distribution boxes should be placed at both the local and remote termination points, typically within 4 to 12 inches of the connection, clearly indicating the source and destination identifiers.

Label Placement Guidelines

Local Termination Point:

- Labels should be affixed within 4 inches of the termination on the visible part of the cable or box to ensure easy identification after installation .
 - Include room number, terminal outlet (TO) number, and jack or port position. If the box is not collocated with a TO, at minimum, indicate the room number .
 - For splitters or taps, use labels such as “From Room ” to indicate the origin of the connection .
- Remote Termination Point:
- Similarly, the other end of the cable should be labeled within 12 inches of the termination to identify the corresponding source or destination .
 - Include identifiers that match the local end, such as the originating room, panel, or distribution box, to maintain traceability .
 - For structured cabling in data centers, labels should reference both the local and remote termination points, including rack, module, and port numbers .
