Placing a distribution box on top of a door is generally not recommended due to accessibility and safety concerns.

Accessibility and Safety Concerns

Distribution boxes, also known as electrical panels or breaker boxes, are designed to be easily accessible for maintenance, emergency shut-offs, and circuit management . Installing a box above a door can make it difficult to reach quickly, especially in emergencies, and may increase the risk of accidents when trying to operate breakers or perform inspections . Electrical codes typically require that panels be installed in dry, accessible areas with sufficient clearance around them for safe operation .

Recommended Installation Height

Standard guidelines suggest mounting distribution boxes at a height of approximately 1.5 meters (around 5 feet) from the floor to ensure they are reachable without ladders or stools . This height allows for safe operation of the main switch and individual breakers while maintaining compliance with safety standards.
