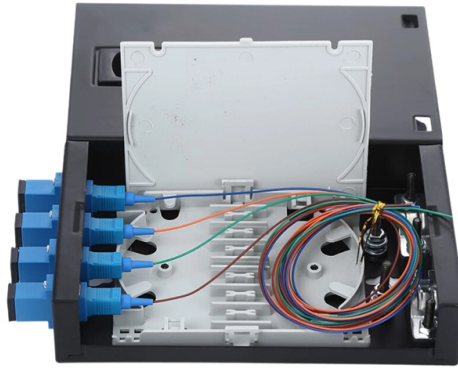


The gateway is set on the access switch

Setting a gateway on an access switch allows the switch to communicate with devices outside its local VLAN or subnet, enabling management and inter-network connectivity.

Purpose of a Gateway on an Access Switch

A default gateway on an access switch serves as the exit point for traffic destined for networks outside the switch's local subnet. This is essential for:

- Remote management: The switch can be accessed via Telnet, SSH, or web GUI from other networks .
- Inter-VLAN communication: If the switch is Layer 3 capable, it can route traffic between VLANs or forward traffic to a router for external networks .
- Network troubleshooting: The gateway allows the switch to ping external devices to verify connectivity . Without a configured gateway, the switch can only communicate with devices within its own VLAN or subnet, limiting management and monitoring capabilities .

How to Configure a Gateway

- Identify the gateway IP: This IP must belong to the same subnet as the switch's management interface .
- Access the switch: Use a console cable, SSH, or web interface to enter configuration mode .
- Set the default gateway:
- On Cisco switches, use the CLI command: `ip default-gateway ...`
