In fiber optic transceivers, pigtails are short optical fibers with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, used to splice into a fiber network.

Definition and Structure

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber, typically 0.5 to 2 meters long, with a pre-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other end. The connector end is polished and tested under factory conditions to ensure low insertion loss and high return loss, while the bare end is designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to a fiber optic cable in the field. This configuration allows the pigtail to act as a bridge between backbone or distribution cables and active equipment like transceivers, patch panels, or optical modules.

Differences from Patch Cords

Unlike fiber patch cords, which have connectors on both ends, pigtails have only one terminated connector and one bare fiber end. Patch cords are primarily used for direct connectivity between devices, while pigtails are intended for splicing applications, enabling clean, low-loss connections to existing fiber networks.
