- **External Supply Instability:** Fluctuations from the utility provider or distributed generation sources can cause voltage instability in the distribution network .
- **Environmental Factors:** Moisture, temperature changes, and corrosion can degrade insulation and components, contributing to unstable voltage .

- **Turn Off Power:** Always ensure the power is off before inspecting the distribution box to prevent electric shock .
- **Visual Inspection:** Look for burnt marks, overheating, or damaged components. Check for loose connections at terminals and breakers
