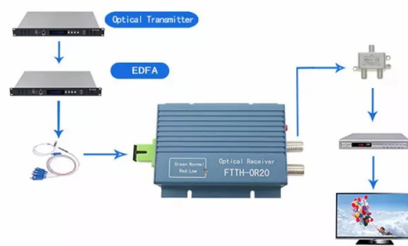


Welding methods for ladder-type cable trays



Article Overview

Ladder-type cable trays are welded using either Cold Metal Transfer (CMT/GMAW) or TIG (GTAW) processes to attach rungs to side rails, ensuring structural integrity and compliance with electrical installation standards.

Welding Methods

Cold Metal Transfer (CMT/GMAW) is commonly used for welding ladder tray rungs to side rails. This method offers low distortion, high precision, and minimal spatter, making it suitable for light-gauge materials as thin as 0.3 mm. CMT welding is efficient for high-volume production and provides consistent, high-quality joints. Tungsten Inert Gas (TIG/GTAW) welding provides greater control over the weld, producing strong, spatter-free, and splatter-free joints. TIG welding is ideal for applications requiring maximum weld quality, though it is slower and more difficult to master compared to CMT.

Material Considerations

Ladder trays are typically fabricated from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, depending on environmental conditions and load requirements. Aluminum offers excellent corrosion resistance due to its natural oxide layer, while stainless steel (e.g., AISI 316L) provides high strength and resistance to corrosion, cracking, and pitting.
