- **Clean the Connectors:** Every connector must be cleaned immediately before mating, even if it appears clean. Dust or debris can cause signal loss or damage the fiber .
- **Align and Mate Connectors:** Insert the connectors carefully into the corresponding ports. Proper alignment ensures low insertion loss and stable return loss .
- **Observe Bend Radius:** Avoid bending the patch cord beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent attenuation or fiber breakage. Indoor patch cords typically have a minimum bend radius of 10 times the cable diameter .
- **Label and Document:** Proper labeling ensures traceability and prevents mis-patching in complex networks like data centers or FTTH installations .
