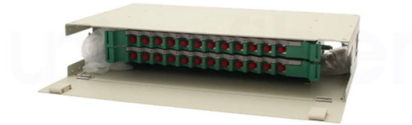


What is a central aggregation switch

Definition and Role

A central aggregation switch serves as an intermediary between the access layer (where end devices connect) and the core layer (which connects to the broader network or data center). It aggregates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, servers, or other edge devices into a single high-bandwidth link directed toward the core network, reducing the number of direct connections needed and simplifying network management .

- **Load Balancing and Failover:** Distributes traffic across multiple links to prevent congestion and ensures continuity if a link fails .
- **Quality of Service (QoS) and Security:** Implements traffic prioritization, VLAN tagging, and centralized security policies to optimize performance and protect the n...
