It acts as the last structured node in the optical network before the fiber reaches the subscriber, providing a secure and organized point for cable termination, splicing, and distribution .

Functions

- **Termination and Splicing:** The box terminates the drop fiber from the distribution network and houses fusion splices or mechanical splices, connecting the main fiber to pigtails that lead to optical network terminals (ONTs) or optical network units (ONUs), .
- **Cable Management and Protection:** It provides strain relief, bend-radius control, and slack storage to prevent fiber damage from pulling, bending, or crushing during installation and maintenance .
- **Optical Performance Maintenance:** The box ensures low insertion loss and high return loss by housing SC/APC or LC adapters, maintaining the optical budget and protecting signal quality .
