- **Fiber Protection:** It prevents bending, kinking, or stress on the fibers, which could degrade signal quality.
- **Connector Access:** The factory-terminated connector ends of pigtails are routed neatly to patch panels or active equipment ports, allowing easy connection and rerouting.
- **Scalability:** Trays allow for orderly expansion of fiber networks, accommodating multiple pigtails and splices in a compact space
