They can be single-mode (for long-distance, high-speed transmission) or multimode (for shorter distances within buildings or data centers) and are often bundled in multi-core configurations to support multiple simultaneous connections .

Patch cords are designed for plug-and-play connectivity, linking devices like switches, routers, transceivers, and patch panels within a network .
