- Reducing installation complexity: Only the required fibers are spliced, avoiding unnecessary work and minimizing the risk of errors.
- Maintaining low optical loss: Skipping unused fibers prevents additional splices that could introduce signal loss or back reflection.
- Enhancing flexibility: Networks can be expanded or reconfigured easily by splicing...
