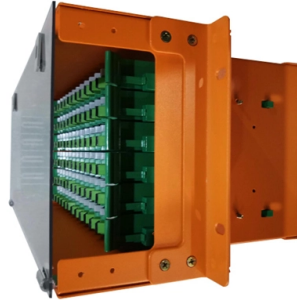


What is the panel for the fiber optic port

Changes in network configuration, such as moving a server or adding new devices, can be accomplished by simply re-patching at the panel rather than rerunning cables . **Protection:** The panel safeguards fragile fiber strands from physical damage, dust, moisture, and mechanical impacts. This ensures long-term reliability and reduces the risk of signal loss .
