Key Principles of Cable Distribution

1. Tray Selection and Type Choosing the correct tray type is essential. Common types include ladder trays for heavy-duty power cables, perforated trays for light to medium-duty cabling, solid-bottom trays for protection against dust or moisture, wire mesh (basket) trays for flexible routing, and channel trays for small instrumentation cables. Ladder trays provide excellent support and allow easy cable entry, while perforated trays offer ventilation to prevent heat buildup.

2. Cable Grouping and Separation Cables should be grouped by type (power, control, data) and voltage level to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI) and ensure safety. High-voltage power cables should be separated from sensitive data or instrumentation cables. Using dividers or separate trays for different cable types is recommended in critical installations.

3. Spacing and Fill Capacity Cables must not overcrowd the tray. Overfilling restricts airflow, increases heat, and complicates maintenance. A general guideline is to fill trays to no more than 50–60% of their cross-sectional area, leaving room for future expansion. Rung spacing in ladder trays is typically 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) to support cables evenly and maintain proper bend radius.

4. Bend Radius and Routing Maintain the minimum bend radius for each cable type, especially for fiber optic and coaxial cables, to prevent signal loss or damage. Avoid sharp bends...
