

What network interface card NIC is needed for a fiber optic switch

SFP is common for 1 Gbps, SFP+ for 10 Gbps, SFP28 for 25 Gbps, and QSFP/QSFP28 for 40–100 Gbps networks . These NICs often have pluggable cages that accept optical transceivers or direct-attach cables, allowing flexibility in deployment . 2. Fiber Type Choose between single-mode fiber (SMF) for long-distance connections or multimode fiber (MMF) for shorter distances . The NIC must support the fiber type used by your switch to ensure proper signal transmission. 3. Speed and Bandwidth Match the NIC speed to your network requirements. For standard traffic, 1 Gbps SFP NICs are sufficient, while 10 Gbps SFP+ NICs are recommended for storage-over-Ethernet applications like iSCSI or NFS to maintain low latency and consistent throughput . Consider future growth and multi-rate NICs that can auto-negotiate between speeds. 4. PCIe Slot Compatibility Ensure the NIC fits your system's PCIe slot (x4, x8, or x16) and supports the required generation (e.g., PCIe 3.0 or 4.0) to sustain the desired throughput . Higher-speed NICs require wider lanes and newer PCIe standards for optimal performance. 5. Ports and Configuration Decide between single-port or dual-port NICs based on redundancy and network design . Dual-port NICs can provide failover or link aggregation for higher reliability. 6.
