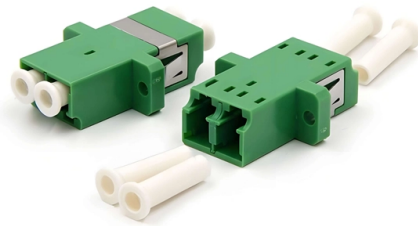


Where to find the model number of a fiber optic switch



Article Overview

You can find the model number of a fiber optic switch by checking the device label, using the management interface, or running CLI commands such as `show inventory` or `show interfaces transceiver` on Cisco switches.

Physical Inspection

Most switches have a label on the chassis that lists the model number, serial number, and other identifying information. Look for stickers on the front, back, or bottom of the switch. This is the quickest way to identify the model without accessing the network interface .

Using the Command-Line Interface (CLI)

For Cisco switches, you can retrieve the model number and related hardware details via CLI commands:

- `show inventory`: Lists all detected hardware, including the switch chassis and installed SFP modules, displaying Product ID (PID), Version ID (VID), and serial numbers .
- `show interfaces transceiver detail`: Provides detailed information about fiber optic transceivers, including model numbers, vendor, and optical diagnostics .
- `show interfaces status`: Displays the status of all interfaces, helping you identify which ports are fiber and which transceivers are installed . These commands allow...
