A DC power supply unit converts AC electricity into stable, regulated DC voltage and current to reliably power electronic devices and circuits.

Core Function

The primary function of a DC power supply is to deliver a consistent and controlled direct current (DC) output from an alternating current (AC) source, such as a wall outlet. Unlike AC, which reverses direction periodically, DC flows in a single direction, making it essential for powering sensitive electronic components, microcontrollers, and laboratory equipment.

How It Works

A DC power supply typically operates through several stages:

- AC Input: Receives electricity from the mains.
- Rectification: Converts AC into pulsating DC using a rectifier.
- Filtering: Smooths the pulsating DC with capacitors or inductors to reduce voltage ripples.
- Regulation: Voltage regulators maintain a constant output voltage and current, even under varying load conditions.
- Output Delivery: Provides stable DC to the connected device or circuit
